

Letter to Next Year's Students!



Please write a thoughtful letter to a student who will be in this class next year.

Help them know what to expect, what to look forward to, and what to do (or not to do) to succeed! Be honest and have fun, but be aware that inappropriate letters will not be passed on.

You can include your name or keep the letter anonymous.

Please include:

- Today's date
- Some indication you are referring to this specific teacher and class (so students know I didn't just steal letters describing someone else's class)

You may (but don't have to) include:

- As much as you want to share about yourself (name, year, grade earned, future plans, etc.).
- What you think the student should know about me (the teacher)
- How well you did in the class, and why
- Your favorite activities or moments in this class
- What to do to SUCCEED in the class, and what not to do!
- What you would do differently if you had the opportunity to do it again.

Feel free to add more! The more specific you are, the more helpful it is!

When you're done...

1. **Write your name** on a yellow sticky note and stick it to your letter. (This is just so I know who wrote the letter - I'll remove it before giving it to next year's students.)
2. Turn in your letter
